New Trips for Next Year

I've just posted our calendar for 2012 and 2013. While many of our most popular trips remain unchanged, we've added exciting new Adventures in Europe and South America and we've expanded the travel options for our [Intro Africa](#) and [Out of Africa trips](#).

One of our new European trips is an addition to our "Peaks of Europe" collection. The [Pyrenees Adventure](#), along with our classic [Alpine Adventure](#) are "trips with an altitude" that feature some of Europe's best motorcycling. Both trips offer premium-level accommodations, meals and support services that have become hallmarks of Ayres Adventures. Our "peerless" [Pyrenees Adventure](#) is a 12-day tour that begins and ends in Barcelona.

Octoberfest, Anyone?

Last-Minute Getaways

For the spontaneous travelers among us, we have a September and an October suggestion. Our nine-day *“Peaks of Europe - the Alps”* is a classic premium Adventure that begins and ends in Munich. The trip ends on September 17 - the first day of *Octoberfest!* Because it’s virtually impossible to book accommodations for Octoberfest at the last moment, we’ve reserved extra hotel nights for riders who would like to stay on to enjoy Octoberfest for a few days after our tour.



The trip includes overnight stays in Germany, Italy, Switzerland and Austria. This 8-day Adventure includes some of the best riding in the Alps, with a two-night stay in luxury accommodations in St. Moritz, one of the most famous towns in Switzerland. Renowned for beautiful landscapes, high fashion, fine cuisine and great hospitality, St. Moritz is sure to be a highlight

of the trip. And as for the passes? You’ll ride many legendary Alpine passes, including the most famous of all - the Stelvio.

Or, pick a different peak! Our *Machu Picchu Excursion* from Cuzco, Peru to Tucumán, Argentina begins October 22. The 14-day itinerary includes Argentina, Chile, and Peru with a visit to Machu Picchu as the trip’s major highlight. Other attractions include Chile’s Andes Mountain resort of San Pedro de Atacama, the Atacama Desert, Peru’s Colca Canyon (the world’s deepest) and Lake Titicaca.



Contingency Planning

Medical Evacuation Insurance & Cancellation/Interruption Protection

Over the years, I’ve found that many riders who would otherwise “take the plunge” and book a motorcycle tour in a foreign country are hesitant because of the uncertainty associated with unexpected contingencies or emergencies that may present themselves in remote locations.

Two questions often come up when riders are considering an Adventure to some foreign destination, such as Africa or South America. One is: “What happens if I become ill or injured while I’m away?” The other is: “what if I have a last-minute emergency that prevents me from being able to participate in a trip for which I’ve already made payment?”

Several reliable companies provide medical and evacuation insurance and some provide it specifically for the days you’ll be on tour. Before each of our trips, our office manager buys a policy for each tour leader and we strongly encourage our guests to obtain one too. While we don’t sell insurance or try to promote a specific company, when asked we refer customers to [Medex](#), the company that we use to cover our tour leaders. We’ve had excellent response with the company on the few occasions in which it’s been needed. Choose a company that covers immediate medical services as well as evacuation, as some companies only cover evacuation.

I recently listened to a recording of a call between [Medex](#) and the victims of a helicopter crash on Mt. Everest. To listen to this recording, [click here](#). Although we aren’t taking riders to Mt. Everest yet, the recording is a good example of the type of support a rider might expect if injured in a less remote part of the world.

We also encourage riders to purchase trip cancellation and interruption protection, which is available through many travel agencies and insurance companies. Most policies includes such unforeseen contingencies as sickness or death of a family member, traveling companion or business partner, employment termination, jury duty, certain conditions which prevent the rider from being able to secure a flight to the departure city for the tour, and several other conditions. If your contingency qualifies, you would be refunded some or all of your payments.
